The Child Nursery Centers (CNC) provides a loving nurturing environment for all children. Our program goal is to help each child develop physically, mentally, and emotionally into a happy, productive and responsible individual.

MISSION

The CNC provides and promotes the highest quality care and education for children and encourages partnerships to support and strengthen families.

NON-DISCRIMINATION

The CNC does not discriminate on any basis in regards to hiring practices or enrollment. The CNC is dedicated to promoting full inclusion of children into all aspects of program services. Every effort is made to provide comprehensive services to all children including those with special needs. CNC is a multi-sited Corporation and provides services in accordance with the ADA. Some of the Centers are in environments/buildings that do not allow us to meet all the physical needs for some children and their families. We make every effort to make reasonable accommodations and will work with your needs to the best of our ability.

HOURS OF OPERATION

To accommodate your needs as a parent, The Child Nursery Centers are open from 7:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. and from 1:00 - 5:00 p.m. It is closed from 12:00 - 1:00 for lunch. Monday through Friday. Clients are expected to return immediately following their court business. In case of emergency, we request notification of any delay in picking up your child.

If a child is still at the Center at 5:30 p.m. and we have not heard from you, they will be considered abandoned and we will notify the proper authorities.

AGES SERVED

The CNC accepts children 6 weeks to 12 years of age.

TUITION POLICY

This service is free.

ADMISSION OF CHILDREN

Any child is eligible to attend if the Parents, Guardian, or caregiver are scheduled to appear in court or conduct court related business for any reason that may or may not be directly related to the child.

CONFIDENTIALITY

All records concerning your child are confidential. Information regarding your child will not be released without your written consent, with the exception of those requested by our regulatory agencies.

The CNC are mandated by Colorado State Law to report any evidence or knowledge of suspected child abuse or neglect to the County Department of Human Services.
